The revised plan will guide the BLM managers in fulfilling their responsibilities for stewardship of the Lander Field Office planning are to best meet the needs of the American Public. The collaborative revision process is designed to provide an opportunity for the public to influence the future management of the landscapes and resources in the Lander Field Office Management Area. The process includes 9 steps integrated into the NEPA process and CEQ guidelines and include:

1. Identification of Issues
2. Develop Planning Criteria
3. Inventory Data and Information Collection
4. Analyze Management Situation
5. Formulate Alternatives
6. Estimate Effects of Alternatives
7. Select Preferred Alternative
8. Select the Resource Management Plan
9. Monitoring and Evaluation

Currently, the process is in the Community Involvement stage.
